3.) "But now, you who once were far away have been brought near through the blood of Christ." (Eph. 2:13). What does that "but now" mean in your life?
<u>DAY 2</u> . Read Ephesians 2:14-18, and answer the questions.
1.) How did Christ Jesus destroy the barrier, the dividing wall of hostility?
2.) What was the purpose of Christ in destroying the barrier (Ephesians 2:15-16)?
3.) Who was the message of peace for? How do we have access to the Father by one Spirit?

1.) By what is the building joined together? And what does it become? (See Eph. 2:21).
2.) Read Ephesians 2:22. We are to be a people where the Holy Spirit dwells. How are you "being built together" for this purpose? What do you need to do to let that take place "in Him"?
3.) What promises from studying Ephesians 2:1-22 will you remember? What change will you let it make in your life today?
